- 5:00 PM The Navigator of the Seas sets sail for beautiful Ocho, Rios, Jamaica.
- 5:15 PM Mandatory information meeting for all festival passengers.
- 6:00 PM Dinner is served in the Swan Lake, Coppelia or The Nutcracker Dining Room. Your group will be seated in the same dining room for each meal.

Dunn's River Falls Adventure: One of the best excursions offered, this privately guided tropical excursion provides you with an unforgettable experience. It begins with your private catamaran cruise from the dock to the beach at Dunn's River Falls. World famous, Dunn's River Falls, is where the clear mountain water cascades down a natural 600 ft. rock staircase into the turquoise Caribbean Sea. For the more actively minded, we have arranged for a licensed guide to escort you as you form a human chain on an exhilarating climb up the falls. If you choose not to climb the falls, there is a viewing area offering exceptional photo opportunities. There will be free time to relax at the Fall's beach before returning to the cruise ship dock. Your private roundtrip Catamaran, Fall's entrance fees and guide are included in this three hour "must see" excursion.
